# Real-life military officer stars in film Battleship



Submitted by Maggie Birchmeier, Hospitality team member The 2012 film Battleship features U.S. Army colonel, Gregory D. Gadson. Gadson was stationed at Fort Riley as a colonel in the early 2000s. The film will be shown in Grosh Cinema Saturday, Dec. 23.

Gregory D. Gadson was born Feb. 19, 1966. He is a retired colonel in the United States Army and the former garrison commander of the U.S. Army Fort Belvoir. He is also a bilateral above-the-knee amputee, occasional actor, and motivational speaker. He served in the U.S. Army for more than 20 years as a field artillery officer and served on active duty for Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm, Operation Joint Forge, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

In 1989, Gadson graduated from the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York. He also holds a master's degree in information systems from Webster University and a master's degree in policy management from Georgetown University. He is a graduate of the Command and General Staff College and the Advanced Field Artillery Officers Course and

in 2010, he became an Army War College Fellow at the Institute of World Politics in Washington, D.C.

Gadson played football at West Point between 1985 and 1988, wearing the No. 98 jersey and serving as cocaptain. In 2007, he was present when the New York Giants beat the Washington Redskins at FedEx Field at the invitation of West Point classmate Mike Sullivan, who was then on the coaching staff of the New York Giants. This win was the beginning of a 10-game road winning streak and came after Gadson had made an inspirational speech to the team. The streak culminated in the Giants winning Super Bowl XLII and in recognition for his contribution, Gadson received a specially minted Super Bowl ring. Gadson has since remained with the team as a motivational speaker.

In 2012, Gadson made his acting debut in Battleship, an American science fiction naval war film as Lieutenant Colonel Mick Canales, playing a war veteran who regains his appetite for the fight when Oahu is threatened by an alien attack. Director Peter Berg, having seen news articles about Gadson, decided to cast him as an army officer trying to recover from the loss of his legs.
